Triple Cities Runners Club Scholarship

AMOUNT: up to \$10,000

QUALIFICATIONS: Be a graduating senior attending college, have participated in varsity cross county and/or varsity long distance track events (1500 meters for women/1600 men).

Greene Central School Alumni Association Award

AMOUNT: Two \$125 awards

QUALIFICATION: Any student who attends a college or technical school after high school graduation.

DEADLINE: Due in Guidance by **MAY 18th**.

Town of Greene Historical Society Award

AMOUNT: Two \$100 awards

QUALIFICATION: Any student that is pursuing history in areas of research, law, journalism, and education.

DEADLINE: Due in Guidance by **MAY 18th**.

Emily Harrold Scholarship

AMOUNT: \$600

QUALIFICATIONS: Student must a resident if the Town of McDonough and be planning to continue his/her education.

DEADLINE: Due in Guidance **MAY 18th**.

GTA Scholarship

AMOUNT: Two \$500 Scholarships

QUALIFICATION: 1) One Scholarship will go to a GTA member's child regardless of the field of study. 2) One scholarship will go to a GCS student entering the field of EDUCATION or a related field (i.e. social worker, counseling, etc.). Essay and letters of recommendation required.

QUALIFICATIONS: Entering the ENGINEERING or COMPUTER SCIENCE Field.

AMOUNT: \$4500

QUALIFICATIONS: Graduating GCS seniors must fill out the loan application, along with proof of college enrollment. Graduates may apply for up to \$1500. Loan repayment begins once the student has left college.
