Triple Cities Runners Club Scholarship

AMOUNT: up to \$10,000

<u>QUALIFICATIONS</u>: Be a graduating senior attending college, have participated in varsity cross county and/or varsity long distance track events (1500 meters for women/1600 men).

DEADLINE: Applications available online

Greene Central School Alumni Association Award

AMOUNT: Two \$125 awards

<u>QUALIFICATION</u>: Any student who attends a college or technical school after high school graduation. <u>DEADLINE</u>: Due in Guidance by **MAY 18th**.

Town of Greene Historical Society Award

<u>AMOUNT:</u> Two \$100 awards <u>QUALIFICATION:</u> Any student that is pursuing history in areas of research, law, journalism, and education. <u>DEADLINE:</u> Due in Guidance by **MAY 18th**.

Emily Harrold Scholarship

<u>AMOUNT</u>: \$600 <u>QUALIFICATIONS</u>: Student must a resident if the Town of McDonough and be planning to continue his/her education. <u>DEADLINE</u>: Due in Guidance **MAY 18th**.

GTA Scholarship

AMOUNT: Two \$500 Scholarships

<u>QUALIFICATION</u>: 1) One Scholarship will go to a GTA member's child regardless of the field of study. 2) One scholarship will go to a GCS student entering the field of EDUCATION or a related field (i.e. social worker, counseling, etc.). Essay and letters of recommendation required. <u>DEADLINE</u>: Due in Guidance by MAY 18th.

Raymond Foundation Scholarship (Three Scholarships Available)

AMOUNT: Up to \$5,000 per year

DEADLINE: Due in Guidance by JUNE 1st.

<u>QUALIFICATIONS</u>: academic achievement, community service, character, motivation and financial need; given to encourage the pursuit of education and a life of continuous learning.

Scholarship 2: George Raymond Jr. Scholarship

<u>QUALIFICATIONS</u>: Academic achievement, community service, character, management potential, motivation and financial need; given to encourage the pursuit of education and a life of continuous learning.

Scholarship 3: George Raymond Sr. Engineering Scholarship

<u>OUALIFICATIONS</u>: Entering the ENGINEERING or COMPUTER SCIENCE Field.

Jane I. Schenck Trust Fund Loan

<u>AMOUNT</u>: \$4500

<u>QUALIFICATIONS</u>: Graduating GCS seniors must fill out the loan application, along with proof of college enrollment. Graduates may apply for up to \$1500. Loan repayment begins once the student has left college.
