Date of Election: Tuesday, May 21, 2024

Petitions with a minimum of twenty-five (25) signatures must be filed with the District Clerk at the G.C.S. District Office no later than **MONDAY, APRIL 22, 2024 by 5:00 p.m. Information must be legible.**

* **Qualified Voter:** To qualify as a voter within the Greene Central School District, a person must fulfill all the following requirements:

1. Be a citizen of the United States of America.
2. Be at least eighteen (18) years old.
3. Be a resident of the school district for at least thirty (30) days prior to the meeting at which he or she offers to vote, and who is not otherwise prohibited from voting under the provisions of section 5-106 of the Election Law.

Regarding residency, owning a home in a school district does not necessarily make the owner a district resident for purposes of being considered a qualified voter eligible to participate in a school district annual or special school district meeting or election. ("A person may have only one legal residence or domicile, and that is the place where such person intends to have his or her permanent residence or home.")

No person shall be determined ineligible to vote by reason of race, creed, color, or sex, who has other qualifications in this section.
