- On motion of Markham, seconded by Youngs, it is RESOLVED, The Board of Education acting pursuant to the authority granted to the Board of Education by New York General Municipal Law §92, grants to any school district employee idled by the COVID-19 school closure, a paid leave of absence for all and any days the employee is prevented from working by the school closure. The leave of absence granted by this action of the Board of Education has complied with the Executive Order issued by the Governor on March 14, 2020 numbered 202.2.
- Superintendent Calice made a clarifying statement: There is no Governmental regulation preventing staff members from working, and it is at the school district's discretion on how staff members will work during the school closure.
- Board member Youngs asked how hourly employees are tracking their time.
- Superintendent Calice stated that hourly workers are being paid for their contracted hours, and no opportunity for additional paid hours above and beyond their contract hours.
- Substitutes are not being paid, as they are only required in the actual classroom during school hours.
- 12 month employees are working as usual; teachers are monitoring on-line student assignments; aides, monitors and bus drivers are helping with delivery of meals on a rotational
