- Superintendent Calice explained that \$98,661.03 needed to be transferred from the Employee Retirement System Reserve Fund to the Capital Reserve Fund in order to meet the 1.5 million dollars needed in the Capital Reserve Fund prior to the vote on the proposed Capital Project. The transfer of these funds will help cover the local share of the project, which will then allow for no tax impact on the taxpayers. After the transfer, the Employee Retirement System Reserve Fund will have a balance of \$1,182,607.47.
