- 5.Put a question mark (?) next to a section you're **questioning or confused about**.
- 6.Use an exclamation point (!) for ideas
 - that strike or surprise you in some way.
- 7.Use arrows () to connect ideas.
- 8. Color code/highlight to determine contrasting or differences.
- 9.Flag (▶) to mark pages with sticky notes.
