Chenango County Music Scholarship

AMOUNT: \$1000

QUALIFICATIONS: A graduating senior who has been accepted to a college or university and who intends to continue his or her education in instrumental or vocal music for classical, opera, jazz, or “show” careers or in teaching music.

DEADLINE: Due in Guidance **MARCH 18th**.

Lucy Funke Scholarship

AMOUNT: \$1000

QUALIFICATIONS: Awarded to a graduating senior entering a one, two, or four year art program in visual, performing, or creative arts.

DEADLINE: Due in Guidance **MARCH 18th**.

Monday Evening Musical Club Scholarship

AMOUNT: Varies

QUALIFICATIONS: College bound senior planning to study music with the intent of pursuing a career in this field. The applicant must have an 85 average and submit application and four letters of recommendation. Audition required.

DEADLINE: Due in Guidance **MARCH 25th**.

The NAACP Tuition Assistance Award in Memory of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.

AMOUNT: \$500

QUALIFICATIONS: Students must submit a 500-750 word essay on “Saluting Greatness: The Legacy of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.” and two letters of recommendation.

DEADLINE: Due in Guidance **APRIL 12th**.

Progressive Dental Community Scholarship

AMOUNT: \$500

QUALIFICATIONS: Graduating seniors who have displayed community interest as well as exhibit academic excellence.

DEADLINE: Due in Guidance **APRIL 24th**.

Cortland County Trappers Association

AMOUNT: up to \$500

QUALIFICATIONS: High School senior with a minimum of a C+ average, college major to be wildlife management, natural resources conservation, forestry, or a related field, provide letter of intent and letters of recommendation. Stop in Guidance for more information.

DEADLINE: Due in Guidance **APRIL 26th**.

Greene Rod & Gun Club Scholarship Award

AMOUNT: \$500.00

QUALIFICATIONS: A senior at GCS intending to pursue a level of higher education by attending an accredited college, university or advanced vocational training institute in the following fields of study: Animal Husbandry, Conservation, Conservation Law Enforcement, Environmental Science, Forestry, Veterinary Science, and Wildlife Management (Consideration will be given to other related areas).

DEADLINE: Due in Guidance **MAY 8th**.

The Donald Franklin Memorial Scholarship

AMOUNT: \$700

QUALIFICATIONS: Senior that will be entering their freshmen year at a two or four year college; active member of an agricultural program or organization (FFA, 4_H, etc.); pursuing a degree in an agricultural related degree program; a resident of Chenango County.

DEADLINE: Applications available and due in Guidance by **MAY 24th**.

The Greene Community Scholarship Fund (formerly Dollars for Scholars) is a nonprofit volunteer organization that provides local students with financial and academic assistance to help them pursue higher education. Selection is based on a point system that takes into account community service, work experience, school activities, awards and distinctions, financial need, advanced classes, GPA, and citizenship.

This scholarship may encompass several local scholarships in addition to the scholarship from GCSF, therefore, you are applying for more than one scholarship at a time with only ONE application, which is well worth your time. Make sure you fill this out!

AMOUNT: \$500 - \$4000

CRITERIA: ANYONE CAN APPLY!! Students have received an application.

SAANYS 2019 Retiree Student Scholarship

AMOUNT: varies

QUALIFICATIONS: applicants must be sponsored by a current SAANYS member (school administrator) and planning to go onto higher education. Letters of recommendation, resume, and transcript required.

DEADLINE: Due in Guidance **MARCH 22nd**.

The Otis A. Thompson Foundation Scholarship

AMOUNT: \$1000 for four years

QUALIFICATIONS: Any graduating senior, who is going to attend a four year degree granting institution.

DEADLINE: Due in Guidance **MARCH 22nd**.

The Philip J. Stacy Memorial Fund Scholarship

AMOUNT: \$1000

QUALIFICATIONS: A graduating senior planning on entering and studying the field of human services.

DEADLINE: Due in Guidance **by MARCH 22nd**.

SUNY Broome Presidential Honors Scholarship for Incoming Freshmen

AMOUNT: Tuition at SUNY Broome

QUALIFICATIONS: A graduating high school senior in the top 10% of your class or have at least a 90 grade point average, planning to attend SUNY Broome, 20 hours per year in campus and community activities. Application, essay, and letter of recommendation all required. (Application states for Broome or Tioga county students but our students are also eligible).

SUNY Broome John and Martha Gerty Scholarship for Incoming Freshmen

AMOUNT: \$1000

QUALIFICATIONS: A graduating high school senior planning to attend SUNY Broome and enrolling in Engineering, Environmental Science, or Liberal Arts in Sciences. Must have a 90 or above average and must have taken chemistry, biology, and math.

DEADLINE: MUST APPLY ONLINE <http://sunybroome.edu/web/www/available-scholarships-for-students>. Due **MARCH 22nd**.

NYSASBO Delaware-Chenango-Ostego Chapter Awards

AMOUNT: Two \$500, one \$1000 award.

QUALIFICATIONS: Student must be planning post-secondary education in business or education.

DEADLINE: Due in Guidance **MARCH 29th**. ***A committee will choose one applicant to nominate from the returned applications.***

Evelyn Emerson Charitable Trust Scholarship

AMOUNT: \$1000

QUALIFICATIONS: High School senior, MUST be a resident of McDonough, and plan to attend college.

DEADLINE: Due in Guidance by **APRIL 1st**.

Linda Jones Memorial Scholarship Award

AMOUNT: \$250

QUALIFICATIONS: Graduating senior with entrepreneurial goals. An essay is required.
