

**POLICY #80**

**LOSS OR DESTRUCTION OF DISTRICT PROPERTY**

The School District will when authorized in law pursue restitution from the parent or legal guardian of a student who willfully maliciously or unlawfully damages or defaces or destroys any public or private property whether real or personal in the care or custody of School District. Restitution shall also be sought when allowed by law where a student wrongfully takes public or private property entrusted to the care and custody of the School District or where such student has falsely reported an incident known as a bomb threat or otherwise taken any action which is violation of the State Law concerning bomb threats. Restitution when sought by the School District will be sought for the amount of damage or to the maximum amount of restitution permitted by law.
