Student Code of Conduct

Student Use of Book Bags/Backpacks

- 1. For the start of the 2020-2021 school year, and until further notice, there will be no use of student lockers in the High School and Middle School halls or locker rooms. All students are to carry personal items and school supplies in their book bag/backpack (books, pens, pencils, etc.). Coats are to be carried and brought to each class.
- 2. Book bags/backpacks will be allowed in class and are to be placed in/near the student's work space.
- 3. Students are advised to safeguard the contents of their personal book bag/backpack. Avoid bringing items of value to school in your book bag/backpack.
- 4. Book bags/backpacks should have student identification (name, grade) marked or displayed in/on the book bag/backpack for personal security.
- 5. For safety and security, student book bags/backpacks are subject to inspection and search from time to time by school officials.
- 6. Students are reminded to carry only essential school items in the book bag/backpack. Contraband, illegal drugs and weapons are expressly prohibited on school property.
- 7. Students are responsible for the contents of their book bag/backpack and should secure it at all times during the school day.
- 8. Students' personal safety and well-being are a top priority of the Greene Central School District.
